

The Newtown Textile Museum is run by a committee of the charity MCRA (Montgomeryshire Community Regeneration Association). The Committee takes full responsibility for the management of, and fund raising, for the Museum.

We are entirely self-funded and rely on volunteers. We have no paid staff.

We have been successful so far in obtaining grants for the general costs and for specific projects at the Museum, such as upgrading the displays on the top floor, improving the digital technology, maintaining the building and the care and management of the collection.

We need to raise the on-going funds needed to keep the museum open. This includes insurance, electricity, and general running costs.

All money donated in the boxes within the museum is used for this purpose. Gift Aid can (and will be claimed) for small sums left in this way, without forms having to be completed. Gift Aid means an additional quarter of your donation coming to the Museum from the Tax Office at no cost to you.

Money donated through the web site is also used for running costs, and may form part of the Friend's membership scheme if the donor signs up to the scheme.

Gift Aid is also claimed on all donations whether sent direct to the Museum c/o the MCRA, or given via the website, where the appropriate agreement has been given.

These will give us your details, together with your consent to the new Data Protection regulations and the Gift Aid declaration. We would encourage all those who are eligible for Gift Aid to do so for maximum benefit.
